

# TAKE 'n TALK

## Special Topic Lesson 1

### GENESIS 1

We are learning that **Our Creator God Is Awesome**. Today we learned God created the planets, sun, moon, and stars. Use the following ideas to involve your child in family time and learning opportunities, reinforcing simple biblical themes.



### HEARTPRINT: OUR CREATOR GOD IS AWESOME

The Heartprint is the main Bible concept or truth from each unit that we want to imprint upon your child's heart. Repeating this Heartprint often may seem redundant, but it will serve as a vital aid in teaching this truth to your preschooler.

**APPLICATION VERSE:** The Lord is worthy of our glory, honor, and power because He created all things (Revelation 4:11).

### EXPLORE



If you have access to a Planetarium, take a visit and explore the stars. Use a telescope to look more closely at the stars one night. If you don't have access to a telescope, just sit outside one evening and gaze at the enormous amount of stars in the sky. Look up information about the different planets, constellations of stars, and the phases of the moon and share it with your child. Remind him or her God is the creator of the universe and **Our Creator God Is Awesome!**

### TALK



This month your child will learn God is the creator of everything. Use any piece of your child's artwork as a launching point for discussion. Ask him or her to tell you about the picture. Ask about the different colors he or she chose for the artwork. Use his or her answers to transition into a conversation about God's creation of the world. Discuss how God had a plan for His creation. He carefully and thoughtfully created everything in a specific order. Be very intentional this month about pointing out God's creation and use these moments to remind your child **Our Creator God Is Awesome**.

### SING



Sing this song to the tune of "London Bridge."

**Our Creator God is awesome.**

**God is awesome.**

**Our Creator God is awesome**

**He is awesome.**

### RESPOND



Pray with your child, thanking God for His awesome creations in the universe. The following is a rhyme your child uses in class to settle down for prayer time:

**Open and shut them, open and shut them**  
(open and close fingers),

**Give your hands a clap** (clap hands).

**Open and shut them, open and shut them**  
(open and close fingers),

**Put them in your lap** (put your hands together in your lap).

Even at this age, children can participate and learn to be still during a short prayer time.
