

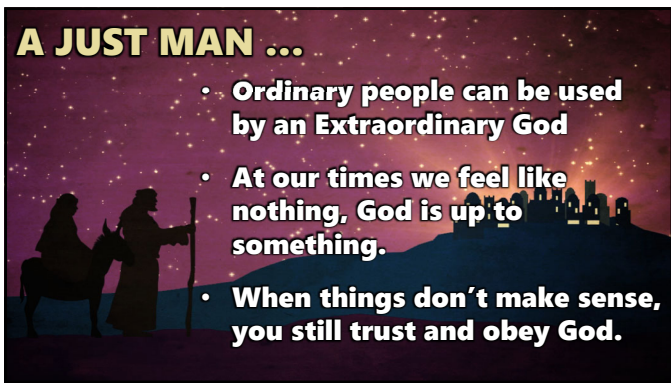






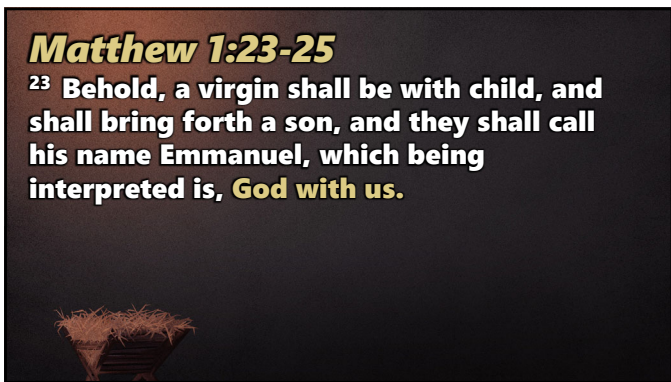
A JUST MAN ...

- When things don't make sense, you still trust and obey God.



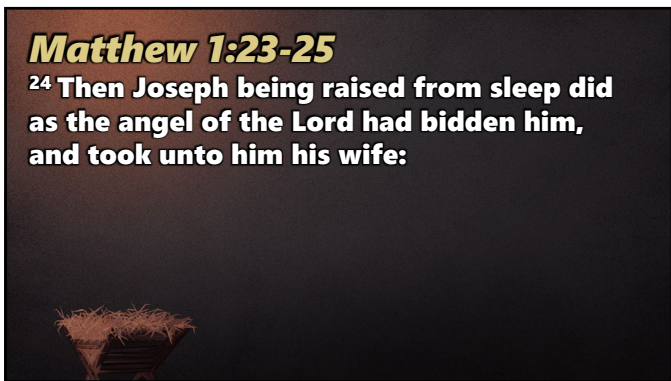
Matthew 1:23-25

²⁴ Then Joseph being raised from sleep did as the angel of the Lord had bidden him, and took unto him his wife:

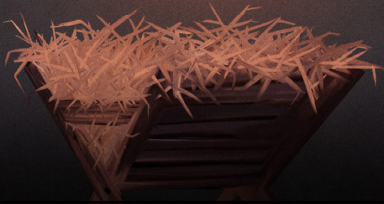

³⁸ When saw we thee a stranger, and took thee in? or naked, and clothed thee?



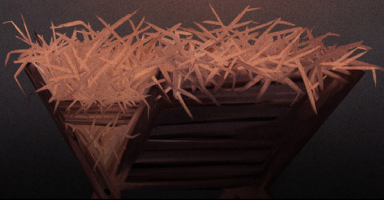

Galatians 2:20

Hebrews 1:1 God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spoke in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, 2 Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;

Upholding (Hebrews 1:3) Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, . .

Saving (Hebrews 2:10) " . . . For it became him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.

Giving grace (Hebrews 4:14) Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession. (15) For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.
