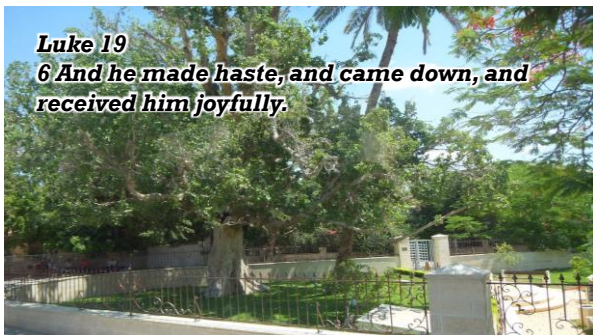


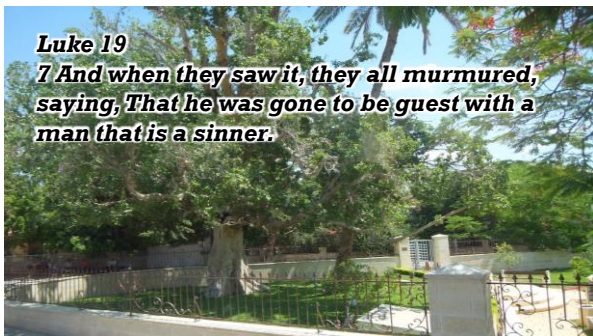
Luke 19

6 And he made haste, and came down, and received him joyfully.



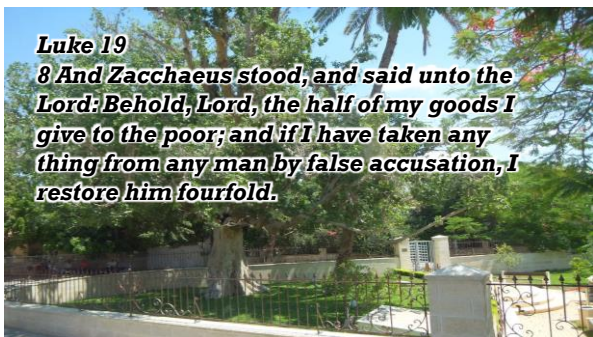

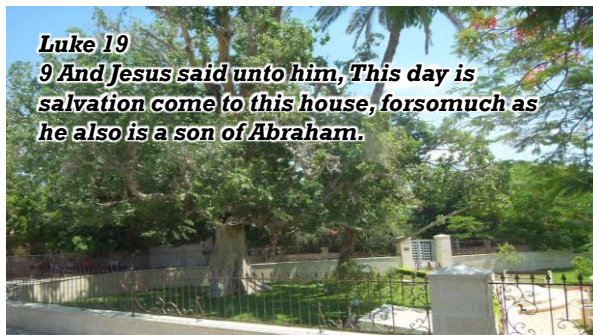
7 And when they saw it, they all murmured, saying, That he was gone to be guest with a man that is a sinner.

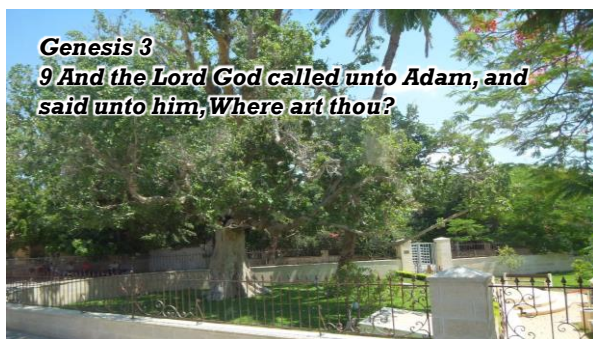
Luke 19

10 For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.

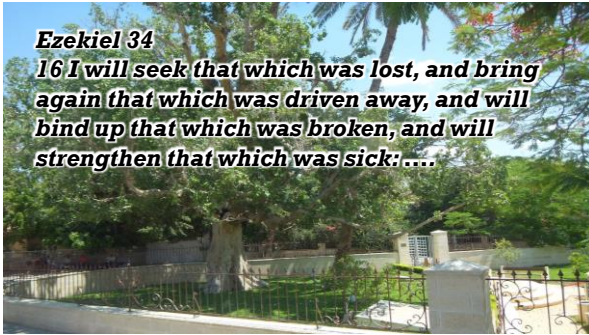


Genesis 3

16 I will seek that which was lost, and bring again that which was driven away, and will bind up that which was broken, and will strengthen that which was sick:....

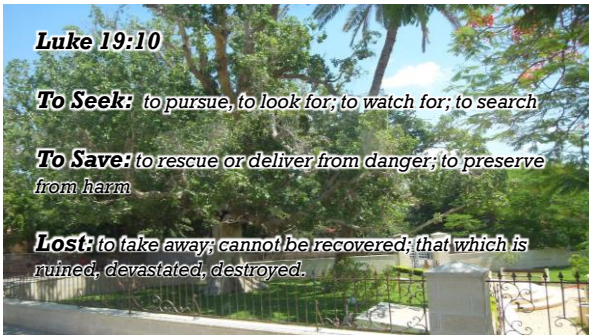


Luke 19:10

To Save: to rescue or deliver from danger; to preserve from harm

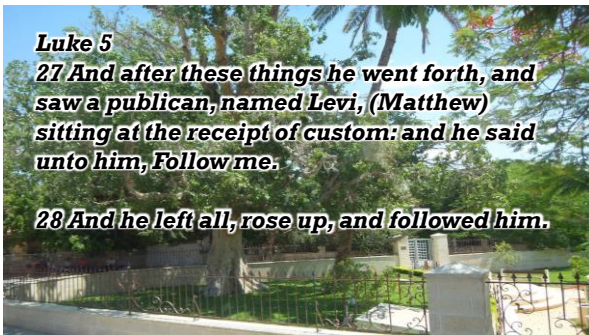
Lost: to take away; cannot be recovered; that which is ruined, devastated, destroyed.

31 And Jesus answering said unto them, They that are whole need not a physician; but they that are sick.

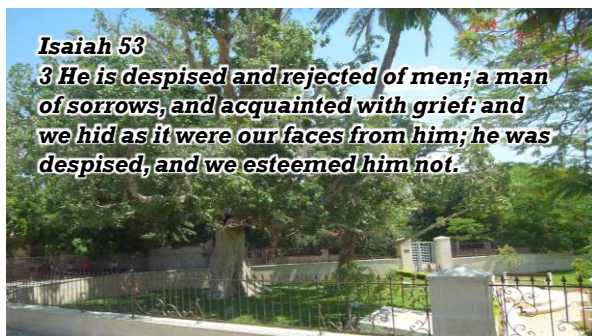
32 I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.

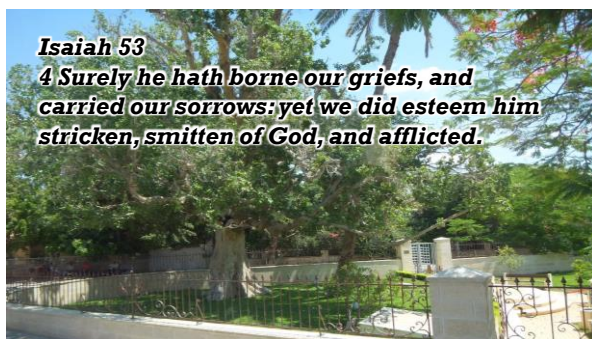
Luke 15

2 And the Pharisees and scribes murmured, saying, This man receiveth sinners, and eateth with them.

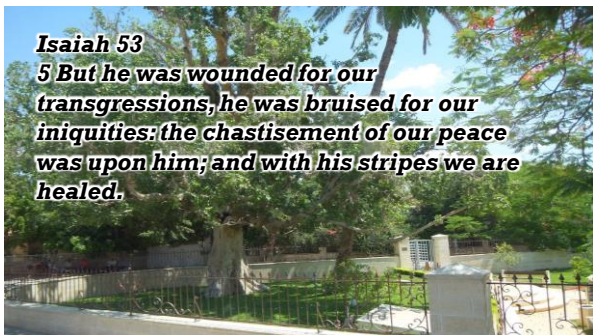






Isaiah 53

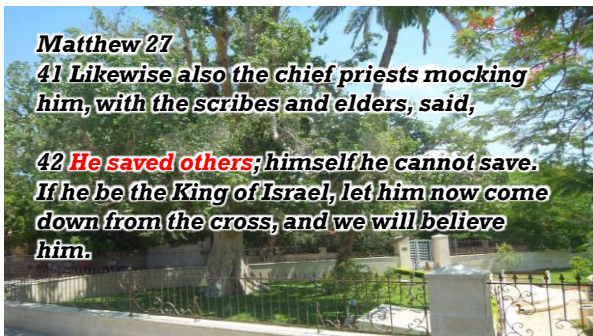
5 But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.
